SUBJECT: Field trips to the Greenway Foundation

The Yakima Greenway is an increasingly popular spot for field trips, which has necessitated a few requests! Please pass this information on to all appropriate persons in your district/school. Thank you!

1. Any one planning a trip to the Greenway should notify the Greenway office at 453-8280 with time, date and number of visitors.
2. The picnic shelter at Sarg Hubbard Park is often reserved for group activities; if another group has reserved the shelter, please respect that reservation and use other areas. If it is not reserved, you may use it on a first-come, first-served basis. If you want to be guaranteed a place, call to reserve the shelter (there is a \$10.00 reservation fee for week-days).
3. If you are travelling by bus, have the driver pull into the lower lot at Sarg Hubbard Park to unload, then park across from Sarg Hubbard Park on 18th Street. NO BUSES IN THE UPPER LOT – there is no room to turn around!
4. Be sure there are enough adults to supervise children at all times. The river and ponds are attractive places for kids – we want to avoid accidents.
5. Keep the children out of the gardens and do not let them climb or shake the trees. Our vegetation is vulnerable and we want it to survive and grow.
6. Remind the students to pick up all of their own litter and collect their belongings. If an item is “left behind” we may have it in our lost & found at the office – call 453-8280.
